## **Gender-based Violence**

Sexual abuse of women and girls, in addition to constituting an abuse of their human rights, represents a significant threat to development programs aimed at their well-being. For example, the contribution of girls' education is widely recognized as having a disproportionate positive impact on a country's economic development. But the so-called "girl effect" is grossly undermined if girls are subjected to sexual assault on their way to school, or in school itself.
